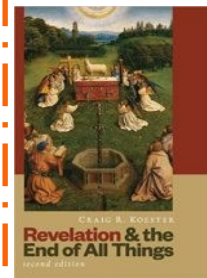

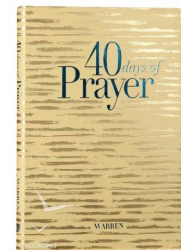


Study the book of Revelation with Dr. Chris Smith and Pastor Jonathan. This exciting study Starts TODAY at 11:15 am.

**Friendship Pad** - Please sign the Friendship Pad in your pew and pass it to your neighbor. At the end of the row, pass the pad back to the inside aisle.

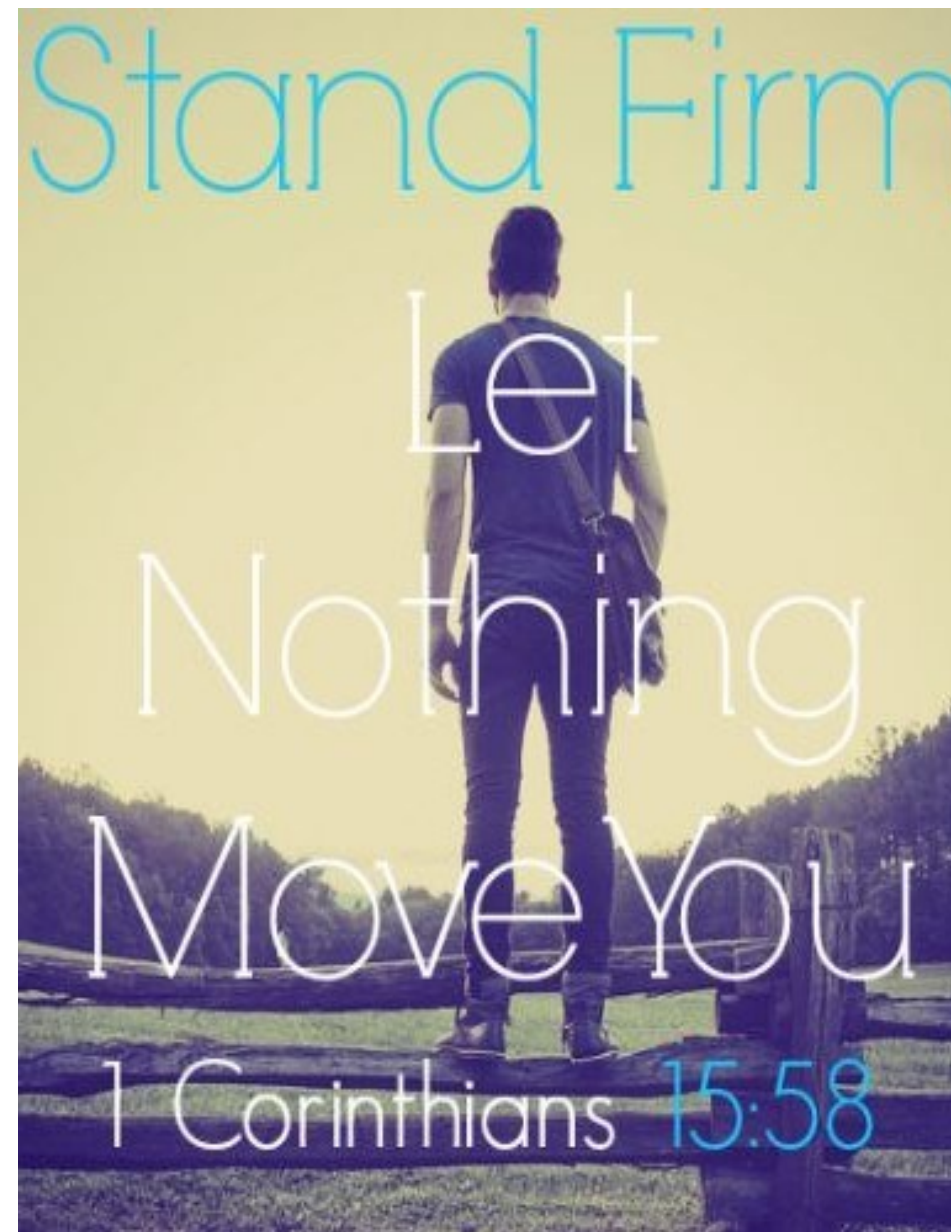
