Almighty and merciful Father, You have called us to be Your people and have made us one body. Yet we have not lived like we are one body.

Your word tells us that love does not envy, that it does not boast, and that it is not proud.
But we confess that sometimes we have been envious, and boastful, and proud.

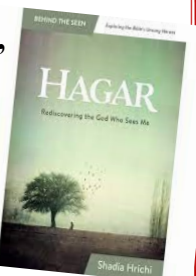
