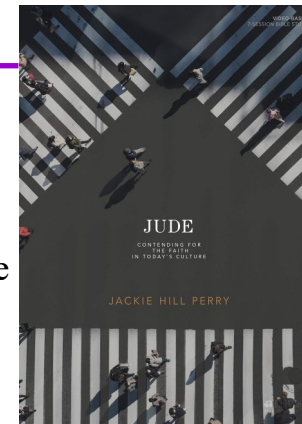
We'll be starting a new Bible Study on, "Jude: Contending for the Faith in Today's Culture."

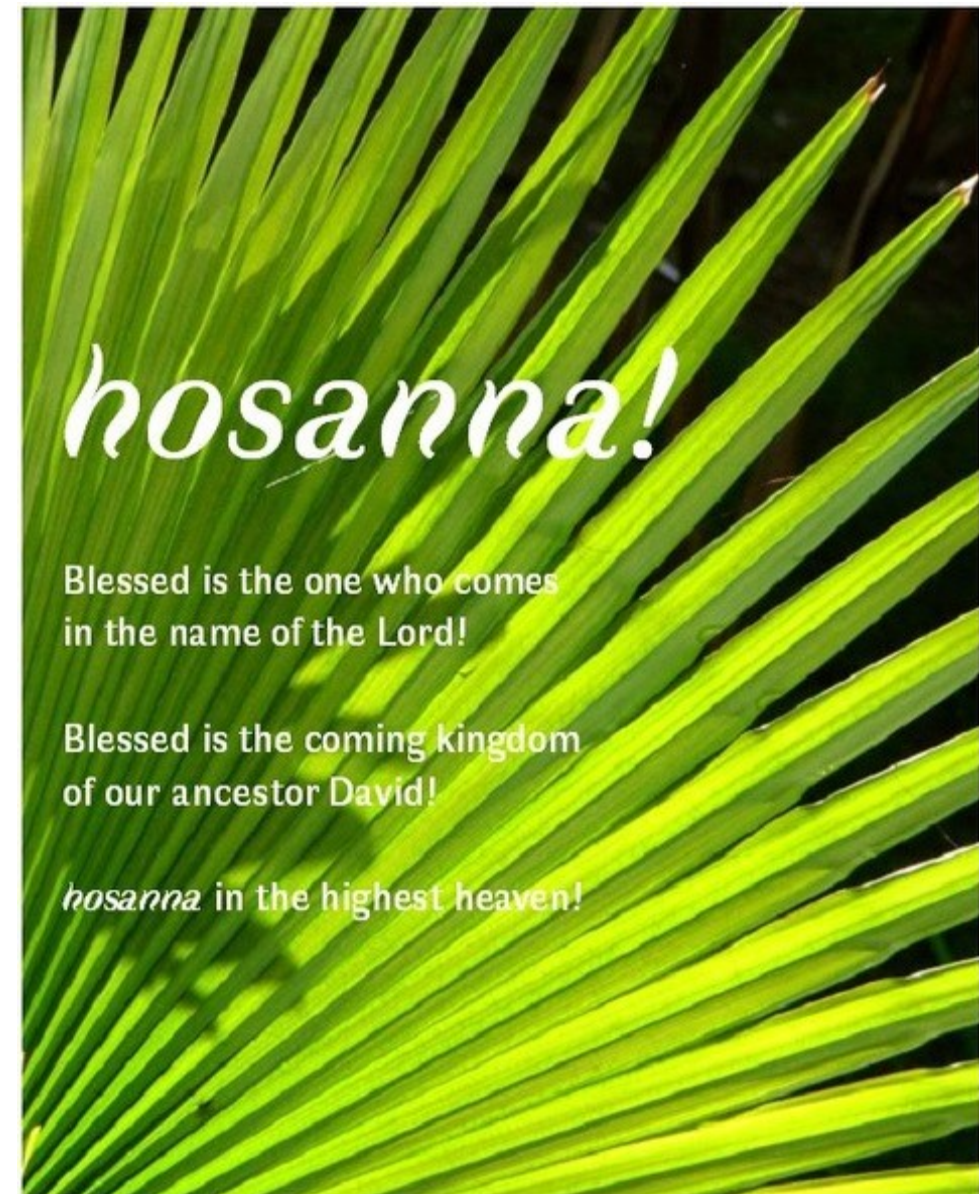
