your neighbor. At the end of the row, pass the pad back to the inside aisle.

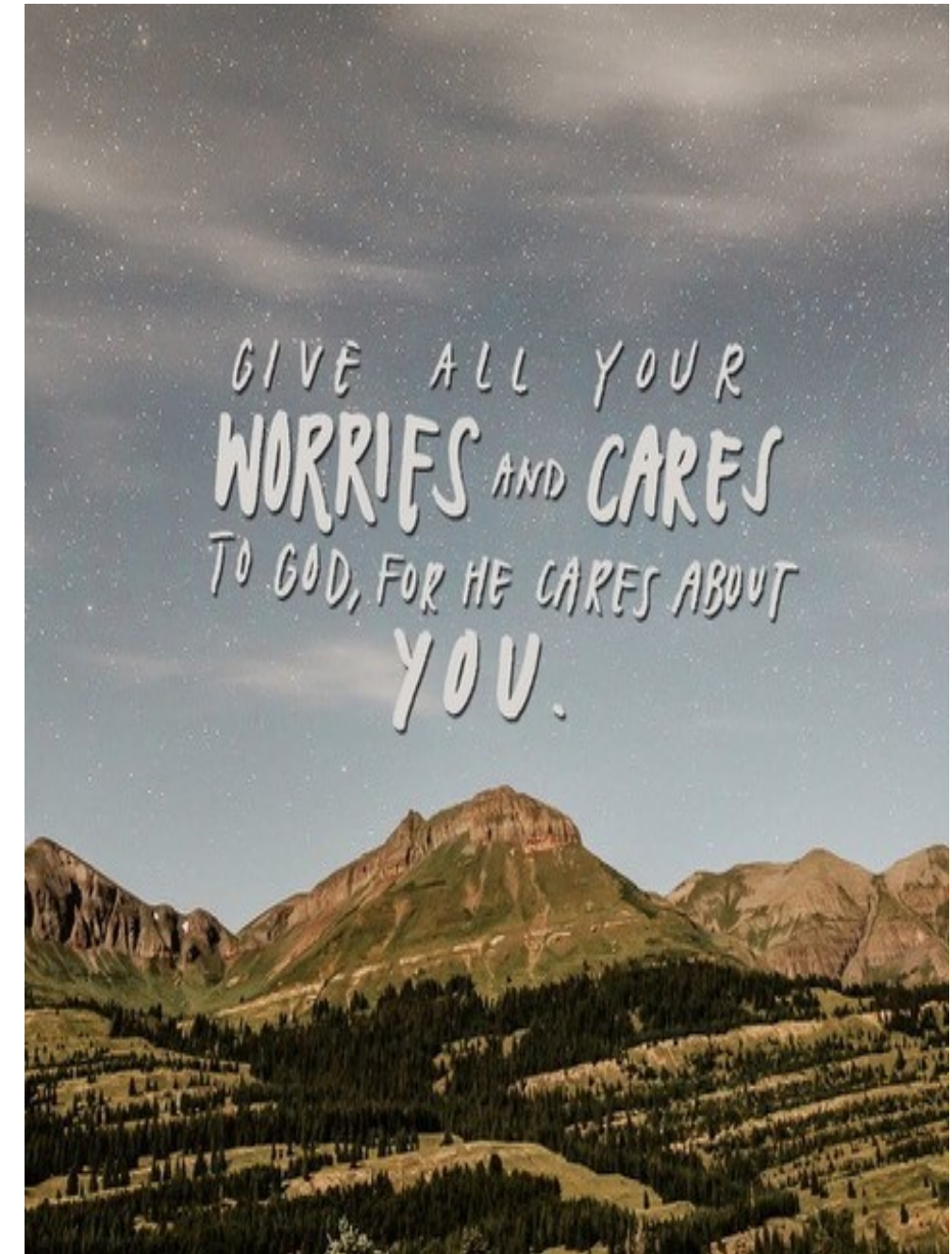
