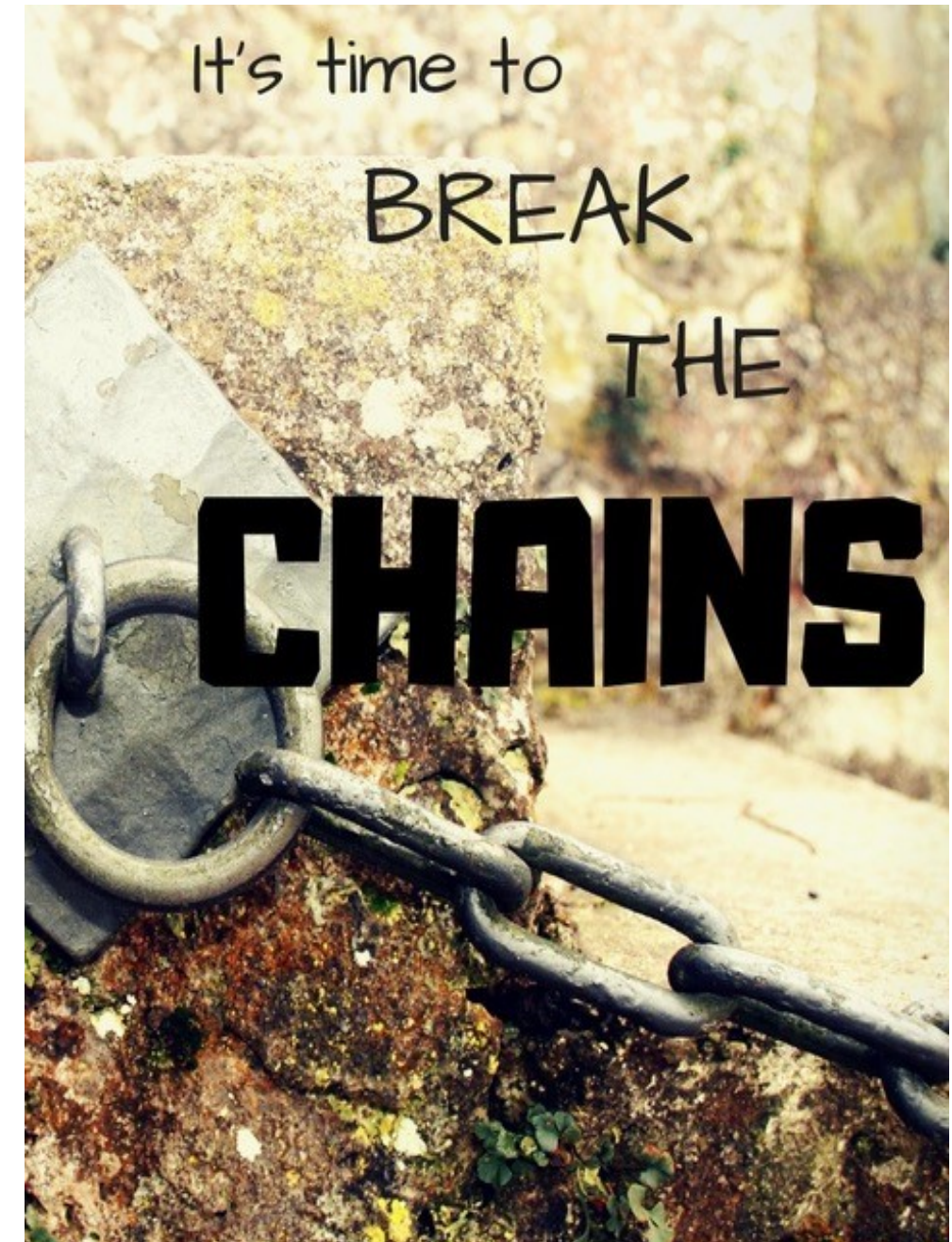
Friendship Pad - Please sign the Friendship Pad in your pew and pass it to
