If you attend regularly, your name will be fine.

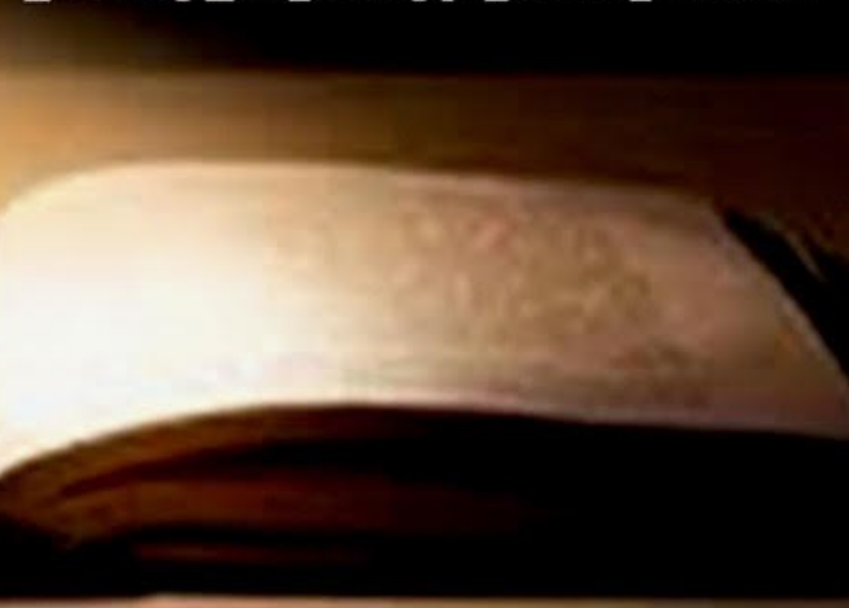
