Sermon Notes: June 1, 2025-Encounters with the Risen Christ: The Disciples Meet Jesus Luke 24:36-49

We're looking at all the appearances Jesus made after he was risen from the dead. Jesus Christ is teaching the disciples (and us) that there is a resurrection for them (and us) that we are to wait for later, and there's a resurrection we can experience now. The concept of the resurrection of the future that Jesus talked about is revolutionary. It's paradigm-busting. Jesus Christ is teaching in this passage, maybe better than any other passage, about the nature of the resurrection, that if we believe in him there's a future for us. If we believe in him, the same thing he entered into, the same reality, the same new creation he entered into, we enter. We begin by looking at three things that happen.

1) He passes through walls

2) He has sensory engagement with the world


3) It is still him

What we're being told is the spiritual penetrated the physical. The Son of God permanently has a perfect physical body.
