

Sermon Notes: June 8, 2025 Encounters with the Risen Christ: The Disciples Meet Jesus Pt. 2 Luke 24:36-49

We're looking at all the appearances Jesus made after he was risen from the dead, the people he saw, the people he met, after he was risen from the dead. Jesus Christ is teaching the disciples (and us) that there is a resurrection for them (and us) that we are to wait for later, and there's a resurrection we can experience now.

Jesus Christ is teaching in this passage about the nature of the resurrection. If we believe in him there's a future for us. This means four things. If you believe this, and to the degree you believe this, you will be different. You'll be like the early Christians.

The doctrine of the resurrection leads you to fight, it leads you to rest, it leads you to love, and it leads you to fear absolutely nothing in a unique way. Look.

1. It leads you to fight

2. It leads you to rest

3. It teaches you love

4. It leads you to fear absolutely nothing. Don't be afraid
