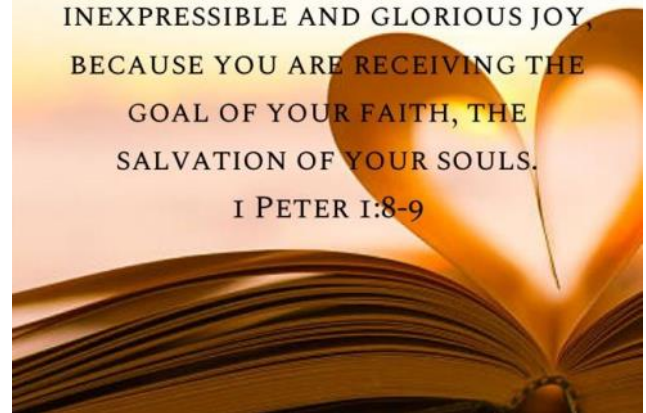

GO MonGOLia Mission On GO!

Are you feeling a nudge or a still small voice calling you to go on a mission trip to stretch your faith?

First Presbyterian Church, Wickenburg, is organizing a mission trip to Mongolia this summer, July 1 -13, 2024. The team will work alongside Mongolian Campus Crusade for Christ team members to help teach English at an English Camp. The team will share in small groups, large groups and possibly one on one. You will have opportunities to share your faith story. All will be done in English, but you will have translators with you as needed. The team will be working with the Mongolian educators and families to improve their English and open doors to share the Gospel. Ebo and Nergui, who were with us at FPC last year, will be the key contacts for the team. The team will have opportunities to interact with their children in English along with other children.

Les and Jeanne Armstrong are organizing the mission trip and will provide an orientation for the team. Ebo and Nergui will organize the time in Mongolia. All travel arrangements will be made by Les and Jeanne and Ebo and Nergui. The deadline for applications is April 5, 2024.

If you are unable to travel to Mongolia, you can still be part of the team through your prayers and financial gifts to GO MonGOLia. The estimated cost of the mission trip is \$3,200, including transportation, lodging, meals, insurance, and miscellaneous costs. Scholarships will be given as the Lord provides. This is a test of faith for those stepping out on this mission trip.
