Sermon Notes: June 22, 2025 "Encounters with the Risen Christ: John Meets Jesus" pt. 2– John 20:1-10

We're looking at all the appearances Jesus made after he was risen from the dead, the people he saw, the people he met, after he was risen from the dead. John is saying, "You can never know the Jesus of before the resurrection. You can never know what we knew, and that is the Jesus of chapters 1–19; but the Jesus of chapter of 20, the Jesus of chapter 21, the Jesus after the resurrection, you can know just like us." Now, the whole issue is what is belief? What is this faith? In the book of John, in the Bible, but in particular in the gospel of John, there is a key; it's belief, believing, faith. This passage tells us this saving faith, not faith in general, is impossible, it's rational, it's personal, it's individual, and it's radical. Every couple of verses gives us one of those principles. Look with me.


1. First, verses 1–3 tell us the kind of faith we must have to unite with Jesus is impossible.

2. Secondly, we're told here faith is rational.

3. Thirdly, faith is personal

4. Fourthly, faith is individual

5. Lastly, faith is radical
